International HWPL Chairman to Host “The Sound of Peace in Chicago” Conference

CHICAGO, Illinois - June 7, 2018 – From the 99th floor of the Willis Tower, the “Sound of Peace” will be proclaimed through the work of Heavenly Culture, World Peace, Restoration of Light (HWPL). The international peace advocate and Chairman of HWPL is making a special journey from South Korea to Chicago for the first time to meet with active and influential legal, religious, civic, and community leaders for the Sound of Peace in Chicago conference. Guests from these various sectors of society will receive an in-depth look at HWPL’s blueprint for world peace.

At the 2013 Peace Gate in Seoul, South Korea, Chairman Lee proclaimed world peace. Since then, the organization has worked to establish a world that can live as one through the proclamation of the Declaration of Peace and Cessation of War (DPCW) on March 14, 2016. Comprised of 10 articles and 38 clauses, the declaration contains three overarching values that can begin to heal the nations; beginning with conflict resolution, conflict mediation, and lastly, securing a way to create sustainable peace. Today, we build war monuments, we build weapons of destruction, and we make profits off of the buying and selling of arms. We live in a war culture, and the DPCW serves as a way to enact a change. With the help of Chicago’s leaders, HWPL can begin the work of adding the US to the growing list of countries in which leaders have agreed to embrace a policy of peace.

Chairman Lee will be presenting the HWPL Peace Advocate Award to twelve outstanding legal, religious, business, civic and community leaders in Chicago who have exemplified through their work, a commitment to world peace.

Article 10 of the DPCW, line 2 states, “In order to preserve a lasting culture of peace, public awareness of the need for, and value of peace should be created.” By promoting peace as an essential building block of a society we can begin and maintain love and unity for all people. This conference, to be held Thursday, June 7, from 6:00 to 9:30 PM at the Willis Tower Sky Deck (99th Floor), 233 S. Wacker Drive, Chicago, will introduce the document being discussed by United Nations’ leaders as an instrument to bring a complete end, and not just a temporary halt, to all wars.
